



Re-Opening Plan/Policies due to COVID-19

Updated July 16, 2020

1. Dancers ages 7+ will be allowed to return to the studio beginning June 1. Dancers ages under 7 will be allowed to return to the studio after July 1. Dancers not ready to return to the studio will be able to register for our Ready, Set, Dance virtual dance program.
2. Dancers will be dropped off curbside and enter through the front door, receive hand sanitizer, have their temperature taken and be asked a few questions about how they are feeling. Parents or caregivers will have to wait in their car or come back for pick up, as our dressing rooms will remain closed. Dancers will enter, take class, and be dismissed directly from the classroom into the parking lot. This creates one-way traffic flow through the building and limits the ability to wander around.
3. In our classrooms, the floors will be marked out 6 feet apart for each dancer, allowing us to put physical distance between each dancer. The instructor will also have an area marked out giving them room to teach while also remaining 6ft away from any dancer. There will be no hands-on corrections, or any other former practices that promote contact between dancers/instructors. Props will be sanitized after use. Instruction will be instructed to remain in center position and physically distant throughout class. For ages 7 and younger, this will be followed to the best of our ability, although we do realize that younger kids can only social distance so much.
4. There will be time in between any class changes with a change of students to allow for proper sanitization of the classroom floor, doors, bathroom and etc. BEFORE a new group of dancers is welcomed into the classroom.
5. Dancers will not be permitted to bring food or any extras into the building. Bring only themselves. They must only bring needed dance shoes and a sealable water bottle labeled with their name. Our water stations will remain closed.
6. Masks will be highly encouraged but not required. Breathing becomes difficult for some in a mask and I respect each family's decision to wear a mask. I will also be asking my instructors to wear a mask while teaching. This is something you may want to chat with

your dancer about. Before opening as I do not want anyone to be scared or worried by the sight of their teacher in a mask.

7. Waiting and dressing rooms will remain closed until it is deemed safe to reopen by health authorities and government mandates.
8. Class times will be adjusted as we will also be limiting some class sizes.
9. Families are not to come to class if they are feeling ill or anyone else in their family is feeling ill.
